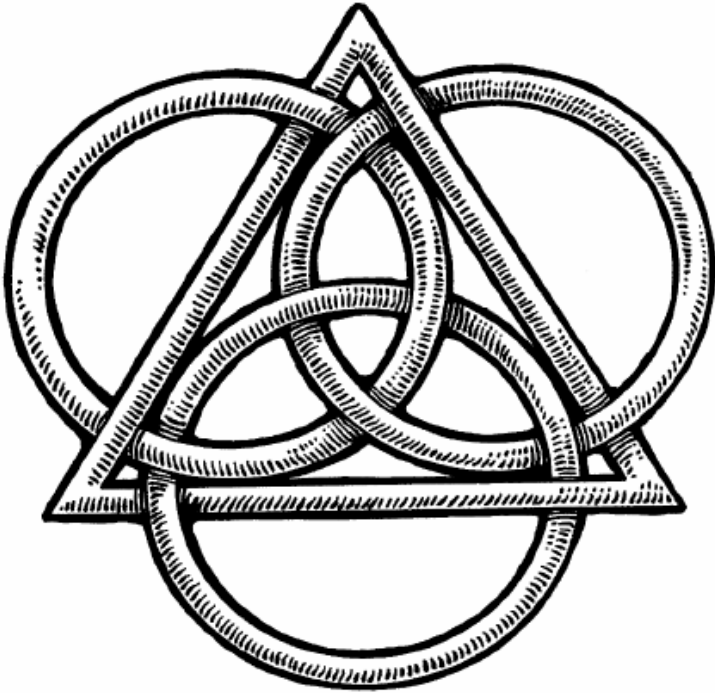

LWML CID Convention - *With thankful hearts, the Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML) Central Illinois District rejoices in the many blessings of our recent convention held in Decatur, Illinois. Delegates gathered in Christian fellowship, worship, and prayerful consideration as important decisions were made to guide the work of our district in the coming years.*

Mite Goal for 2026–2028 - \$220,000 Biennium Goal. As part of this new biennium, delegates approved an updated mite goal of \$220,000. 75% of mites will remain in the CID to fund district mission grants, 25% will be contributed toward national LWML mission grants. This structure allows us to continue supporting meaningful ministry work both locally and across the broader mission field.

The following Lectionary Summary, provided by the LCMS, serves as a guide to help understand the theme of the readings for each Sunday as well as how they fit into the particular season of the Church Year.

The Holy Trinity Reveals Himself to Sinners

When Isaiah beheld the glory of the Lord, he cried out *“Woe is me!”* For the sinner cannot stand in the presence of a holy God and live (Is. 6:1–7). But God the Father lifted up His Son Jesus for us on the cross, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. This eternal life of Christ is given us according to the Holy Spirit’s good pleasure in Baptism. *“Unless one is born [again] of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God”* (John 3:5). To sinners in fear of death, the messengers of God place on our lips the living body and blood of Christ and speak His words of absolution, *“Your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for”* (Is. 6:7). Having received forgiveness and life from the Father through the Son by the Holy Spirit, we join with the angels in praising the blessed Trinity, *“Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts!”* (Is. 6:3). *“For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him be glory forever. Amen”* (Rom. 11:33–36).

Thought for the week...

Isaiah 6:3 – “And one called to another and said: ‘Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!’ ” Three times the angels cry out: “Holy, holy, holy!” It is an indication of the three-ness in God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This is the Name into which we are baptized. We have been made a part of God’s family and are now called to live lives that are in harmony with this new family. We are to be godly and live in God’s image. As God is loving, kind and generous, so also are we called to be.
